Researchers provided two novel methods at the protein and mRNA levels to minimize non-specific mismatches between single guide RNA and target DNA by chemically conjugating Cas9 with zwitterionic pCB polymers or genetically fusing Cas9 with zwitterionic (EK)_n peptides. The zwitterlated or EKylated CRISPR/Cas9 ribonucleoproteins showed reduced off-target DNA editing while maintaining a similar level of on-target gene editing activity. Abstract

Their latest work, published in Cancer Cell, took aim at a mysterious protein called ARID1A — a chromatin-remodeling component that had recently been identified as a tumor suppressor commonly mutated in bladder cancers.
